# **Choosing Courses**

Students must earn the following compulsory credits to obtain the Ontario Secondary School Diploma:

- 4 credits in English
- 3 credits in mathematics
- 2 credits in science
- 1 credit in Canadian history
- 1 credit in Canadian geography
- 1 credit in arts
- 1 credit in health and physical education
- 1 credit in French as a second language
- 0.5 credit in career studies
- 0.5 credit in civics Plus one credit from each of the following groups:
  - English, Another Language, Social Sciences, Canadian and World Studies, or Cooperative Education
  - Physical Education, The Arts, Business Studies, or Cooperative Education
  - Science, Technological Education, or Cooperative Education

In addition to the compulsory credits, students must complete:

- 12 optional credits
- 40 hours community service
- the Grade 10 literacy test
